# Volunteer Roles

**Annual weed surveys** (DNR required/trained) - To identify new weed beds for spraying and monitoring treatment success.

**Education at boat landings** (DNR required/trained) - Clean Boats Clean Waters Program teaching the public about the proper procedures of cleaning boats and trailers to prevent transferring exotic species (weeds, fish, organisms, and virus's) to other lakes.

**Publish quarterly newsletters** (DNR required) – Writing and/or proof reading articles on current lake issues for publication in the member's newsletters.

**Record maintenance** (Association function) - Keeping member database and other vital information up to date.

**Clerical help** (Association function) – Mailing documents to members, stuffing envelopes, etc.

**Community relations** (Association function) – Submitting education articles to local newspapers, acting on questions from the members, town board, or others, creating a watch system to head off future potential problems.

**Raising funding for treatments** (Association function) – Help carrying out request for donations and helps on possible future fund raising events that might be held at the Sportsman's Park.

**Placing and removing buoys** - Installing them in spring and removing, washing, and storing them in the fall.

**Safety programs** – Helping with the DNR sponsored safety programs for our youth.
